A 2019 SURVEY COMPLETED BY 60 EUPATI GRADUATES FROM 22 COUNTRIES REVEALS

82%

Declare training to be useful and essential in their activities

85%

Believe there are actions they have done since training they would not have done before

66%

Cannot explain their ENPs role and activities

<50%

Are involved in their ENPs activities

WHILE FELLOWS ATTEST TO THE VALUE OF THE TRAINING, MANY EXPRESSED A LACK OF KNOWLEDGE ABOUT THEIR ENP

1 Regular communication & meetings between ENP & Fellows



2 Mentoring of Fellows including clear membership rules and activities for Fellows within ENPs

Create joint work plan for ENP & Fellows



Administrative resources to support Fellow engagement with ENP



Financial resources to support Fellow engagement with ENP



Sharing best practices for Fellow engagement between ENPs
