

EUPATI Annual Report 2020



The following report is an overview of the main achievements of the European Patients' Academy for Therapeutic Innovation in the calendar year 2020. The structure of the report is based on the EUPATI Workplan 2020.

2020 saw the establishment of a new EUPATI Foundation based in the Netherlands, as well the development of a new governance structure. These aspects resulted in subsequent changes in the administration and will allow for the full implementation of the sustainability plan.

Major changes were also introduced in the core activity of EUPATI, the Expert Patient Training Programme. An on-demand online learning platform, the EUPATI Open Classroom, was launched in December 2020.
