EUPATI has already trained over 250 patient experts on medicines research and development (R&D), including clinical trials, regulatory affairs and health technology assessment via its Patient Expert Training Programme and provides training and education to hundreds of patients via its open-access EUPATI Open Classroom. Additionally, EUPATI offers and maintains an online Toolbox on medicines R&D, coordinates a network of 24 EUPATI National Platforms and maintains the EUPATIconnect platform to facilitate collaboration between expert patients and researchers.

EUPATI works on a variety of activities and the foreseen internship project may be adjusted to the candidates' profile.

1. Improving the EUPATI Online Toolbox

- Mapping, organising and coordinating the development of new toolbox materials and translations in 13 languages <https://toolbox.eupati.eu/>
- Monitoring the use of the Toolbox and access to the different language versions
- Promoting the Toolbox through a social media campaign
- Coordinating the creation and production of new Toolbox articles in different topics of interest

2. Supporting EUPATI Communications towards different stakeholders

- Creating social media content, designing/selecting images for EUPATI communications (website, Twitter, LinkedIn, Facebook)
- Monitoring different channels for relevant content for sharing
- Assisting in designing and drafting bi-monthly newsletters for EUPATI's networks
- Assisting in creating different media content (video, podcasts)
- Assisting in creating promotional material for the launch of EUPATIconnect Matchmaking platform (to enhance patient engagement and collaboration of EUPATI patient experts with industry/academia)

3. Support EUPATI Training portfolio
