PROPOSED TRAINEE PROJECTS

1. Support EUPATIconnect Matchmaking platform

- Assisting in coordinating the matchmaking requests and in communications with researchers and EUPATI expert patients
- Assisting in maintaining and expanding the database of expert patients
- Assisting in following up on collaborative projects and collecting case studies
- Assisting in evaluating the uptake of the platform

2. Improving the EUPATI Online Toolbox

- Mapping, organising and coordinating the development of new toolbox materials and translations in 14 languages <https://toolbox.eupati.eu/>
- Monitoring the use of the Toolbox and access to the different language versions
- Promoting the Toolbox through a social media campaign
- Coordinating the creation and production of new Toolbox articles in different topics of interest
